

Universidad Politécnica de Texcoco has planted new trees inside campus as part of the Maintenance Program, as part of the **BIS model**.

Bushes, pine trees, and various flowers have been planted to counteract the natural arid soil of the place and embellish the green areas. The university community has participated in these activities.

Three solar-powered phone charging stations, including tables and seats that can be used as study places, have been installed among the green areas.
